

TB Test & Immunization for New Members

Enclosed is a Medical Immunization Form that must be completed and signed by you and your child’s physician and returned to us before your child may attend Menlo-Atherton Nursery School. Please note that as of July 1, 2001, the varicella (chickenpox) vaccine is required.

In addition, proof of a negative TB test is required for:

- All parents who plan to work at the school more than 3 times during the course of the school year.
- All teacher-approved caregivers or relatives who will be attending school more than 3 times during the course of the school year.

This TB test must be one of the following:

- an intradermal Mantoux 5TU PPD skin test, (not a four prong tine test)
- a chest X-ray

You may get your test through your doctor or a health clinic. The San Mateo County Department of Health offers inexpensive tests. For information, please call (650) 573-2346. You may use the form below to obtain written verification of your test and the results. The TB test is valid for four years. If you have had one in the last four years, you may send us proof of the test instead of having another test.
